



SAINT-ESTEPHE



Château Laffitte Carcasset was founded in 1759 at « Le Carcasset » an area located in the heart of Saint-Estèphe appellation. In 1781 his owner, Jean Laffitte, lawyer and prosecutor of the King Louis XVI in Bordeaux, gave his name to the estate.

This beautiful chartreuse typical of the 18th century, is surrounded by the most famous Classified Growths in Saint-Estèphe. The 35 hectares vineyard is on the gravelly plateau of the appellation where the cabernet and the merlot best express their potential.

Château Laffitte Carcasset has been Cru bourgeois since 1932 and a family vineyard from the origins. It belongs nowadays to Pierre Rousseau and his family.
